- Implement and maintain an Environmental Management System to adhere to AS/NZS ISO14001:2004 and which is a vital part of our integrated business system
- Comply with relevant Environmental Protection Legislation and other regulatory requirements in the state in which our services are provided
- Continually improve our environmental management performance through periodical reviews – generally through our Business Review Meetings where environmental issues are a permanent agenda item
- Develop and set environmental benchmark objectives on an annual basis and review performance against these – e.g. plan to cut power usage during each year of operation
- Communicate Busicom’s environmental policy to all employees, contractors, clients and the public – through newsletters, webpage updates and staff induction and training sessions
- Reclaim used materials/containers where appropriate and recycle them where possible
- Implement our detailed management action plan in the event of an environmental accident (e.g. chemical spillage)
- Seek to develop energy and resource saving work methods – e.g. avoid leaving machinery running when not in use
- Seek to develop work methods that reduce the risk of environmental damage – e.g. carry only sufficient chemicals to complete jobs satisfactorily
- Maintain knowledge of and compliance with relevant eco-related legislation and regulations – refer to the company’s Regulatory Monitoring Procedure and download the latest environmental rulings and requirements
- Adhere to Waste Minimisation and Management Act, 1995 (NSW) (as amended) when transporting waste and dispose of correctly at licenced facilities.
